WHEREAS, there are more than 35,000 active members in over 600 chapters of this organization throughout the country; and

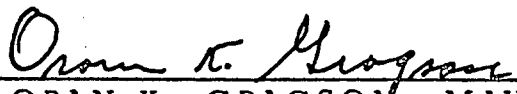

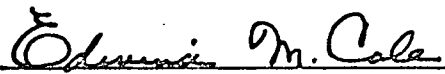
AMERICAN BUSINESS WOMEN'S WEEK
