WHEREAS, the men of Optimist International have dedicated themselves to promoting community-wide recognition of our fine young people during Youth Appreciation Week each year, and

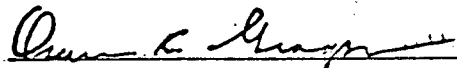

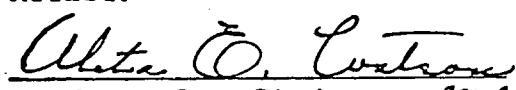

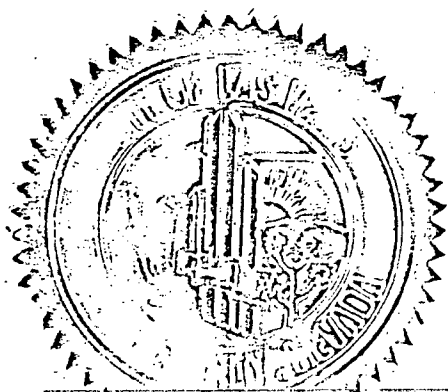
