NOW, THEREFORE, I, ORAN K. GRAGSON, as Mayor of the City of Las Vegas, do hereby proclaim that

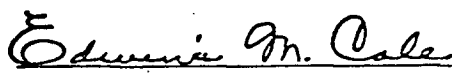
NATIONAL CRIME PREVENTION WEEK

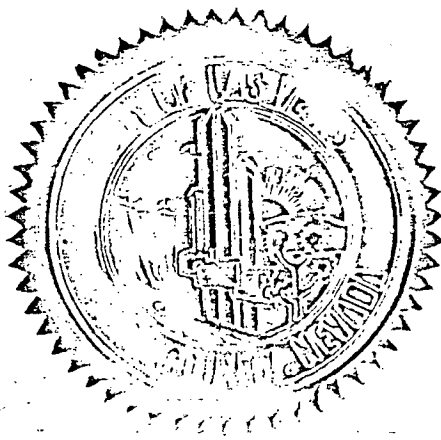
