WHEREAS, the People-to-People Health Foundation, Inc., sponsors Project HOPE (Health Opportunity for People Everywhere); and

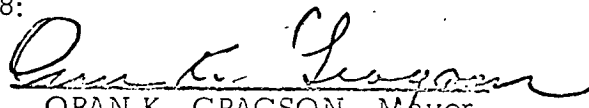

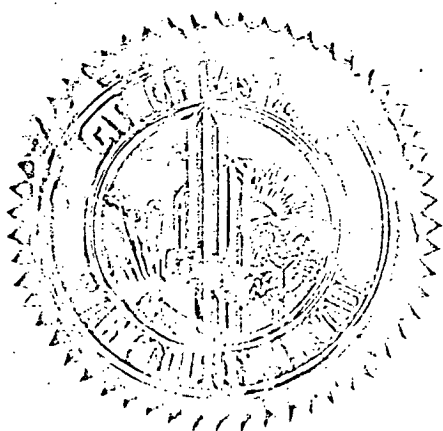
WHEREAS, these missions have brought teaching and training to medical personnel of newly emerging nations, and health, happiness and greater productivity to thousands of people of these nations; and
