WHEREAS, this gathering of distinguished guests and famous sports personalities will bring renown and reflect credit to the City of Las Vegas; and

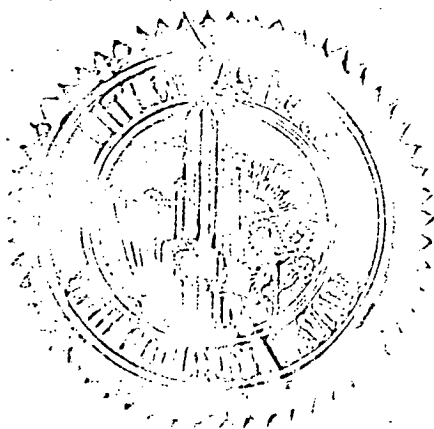
