

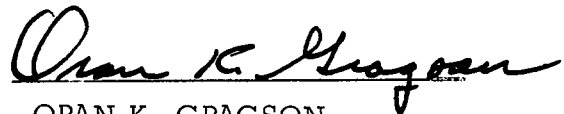
PROCLAMATION

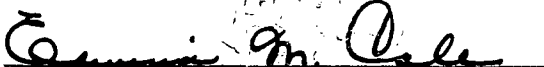
