WHEREAS, the world has heard with profound sorrow and deep regret of the death of DWIGHT DAVID EISENHOWER, twice President of the United States and General of the Army for many years; and

WHEREAS, DWIGHT DAVID EISENHOWER led this nation and the Allied Forces in time of war and thereafter became a statesman and leader of the world in its endeavors to find peace and was always held in the highest esteem by the leaders of the world and its citizens; and

WHEREAS, his accomplishments and endeavors merit the highest respect and tribute on behalf of the residents of the City of Las Vegas,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ORAN K. GRAGSON, Mayor of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, do hereby proclaim Monday, the 31st day of March, 1969, as a day of mourning within the City of Las Vegas, and urge the citizens to participate in religious or memorial services for DWIGHT DAVID EISENHOWER.
