WHEREAS, the American Legion Women's Auxiliary have voluntarily given their time and efforts each year towards making poppy day a success.

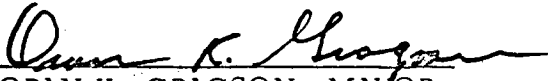

"POPPY DAY"

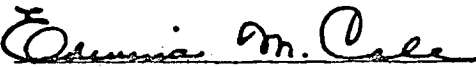
and urge the citizens of Las Vegas to join with me in the promotion and activities of this worthy, annual observance.
