

Proclamation

WHEREAS, traffic accidents cause a staggering waste of life and property; and

WHEREAS, motor vehicle accidents in Nevada during 1968 numbered 15,166, including 219 fatalities; and

WHEREAS, it is the individual responsibility of every citizen to help prevent traffic accidents; and

WHEREAS, the City of Las Vegas will participate in the 1969 National Vehicle Safety-Check by alerting drivers to possible danger spots in the vehicles they drive:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ORAN K. GRAGSON, Mayor of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, do hereby declare the period of May 12-18, 1969, as

VEHICLE SAFETY CHECK WEEK

in the City of Las Vegas, and hereby urge all traffic organizations, public officials, public information media, service and trade organizations, industries, schools and churches and all citizens to take an active part in this traffic safety program and to help everyone get the safety habit.
