

Proclamation

WHEREAS, Epsilon Sigma Alpha, a non-academic sisterhood, was organized in 1929 by a group of culturally minded women, and celebrates its founding with the observance of E.S.A. Week, May 1 - 7; and

WHEREAS, E.S.A. members are active women who accept the challenge to keep pace with the constant innovations in our modern social structure; and

WHEREAS, each chapter has an educational program that fits the interest of its members, such as astrology, religion, crafts, stock market, law enforcement, medicine, etc., and

WHEREAS, E.S.A. has a membership of more than 40,000 sisters throughout the world, with a combined membership of 850 women in Nevada and Arizona comprising the Arizona Council; and

WHEREAS, this year, through its philanthropic "Rhapsody in Blue Ball" the Arizona Council is able to donate \$2,000. to the research burn unit in Phoenix, and has awarded two scholarships to worthy students; and

WHEREAS, The Alpha Iota Chapter of Las Vegas has as its project the Opportunity Center for mentally retarded children;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ORAN K. GRAGSON, Mayor of the City of Las Vegas, in recognition of the outstanding public services of this organization, do hereby declare the week of May 1 - 7, 1969, as:

in Las Vegas, Nevada, and do hereby urge the citizens of this community to support this organization and its many humanitarian causes.
