WHEREAS, transportation is the lifeline in the economy and in the strength of this nation; and

WHEREAS, the transportation industry and our citizens engaged therein are making a vital contribution to the economy of this area and to the general well-being of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the continued growth of tourism as a major phase of our economic structure, and continued growth and development of the City of Las Vegas and the Southern Nevada region relies upon transportation; and

WHEREAS, it is proper that recognition be given and that special tribute be paid this industry and the men and women engaged therein; and

WHEREAS, the Southern Nevada Chapter of the National Defense Transportation Association is joining other chapters throughout the United States in special observance of the important role of transportation;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ORAN K. GRAGSON, Mayor of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, do hereby proclaim the period May 12-16 as

NATIONAL DEFENSE TRANSPORTATION WEEK

and do hereby further proclaim May 16, 1969, as

NATIONAL TRANSPORTATION DAY

in the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, and urge all citizens to join in special observance of this occasion.
