WHEREAS, Las Vegas has been nationally recognized as the city which, for its size, has generated the highest level of airline traffic of any other city in the United States; and

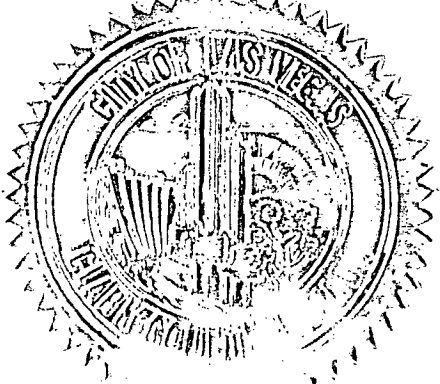
