WHEREAS, by proclamation, the President of the United States designates a period in October for the national observance of fire prevention activities; and

WHEREAS, each year preventable fires claim the lives of thousands of our citizens, and cause permanent disability to countless others; and

WHEREAS, the destruction by fire of our natural and created resources is ever increasing;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ORAN K. GRAGSON, Mayor of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, do hereby proclaim the month of October, 1969, as:

FIRE PREVENTION MONTH

in the City of Las Vegas, and do hereby appeal to all citizens to eliminate all possible causes of destructive fire in his home and place of business, and I urge the vigilance against fire be extended beyond "Fire Prevention Month" and zealously continued throughout the year.
