

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, civil disturbances have occurred on October 5, 1969, and October 6, 1969, in the area bounded on the west by Tonopah Highway, on the north by the North City Limits of the City of Las Vegas, on the east by Main Street, and on the south by Bonanza Road; and


WHEREAS, it is threatened that these civil disturbances will continue for an indefinite period,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ORAN K. GRAGSON, Mayor of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, do hereby find that a public disorder and riot exists within the above described area of this City which presents a threat to life, health, property and the public peace and do therefore proclaim that a state of emergency exists in the said described area, and I do further proclaim that a curfew shall be in effect from 7:00 P.M. on each day until 6:00 A.M. of the following day, commencing at 7:00 P.M. on October 6, 1969, and continuing until this Proclamation is rescinded, in the area bounded on the west by Tonopah Highway, on the north by the North City Limits of the City of Las Vegas, on the east by Main Street and on the south by Bonanza Road, and all persons are prohibited from being on the public streets, in any public park or at any other public place within said area during the period of said curfew.
