

RESCISSION OF PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, a Proclamation was made by the undersigned Mayor of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, on the 6th day of October, 1969, proclaiming a curfew from 7:00 P.M. on each day until 6:00 A.M. of the following day in the area bounded on the west by Tonopah Highway, on the north by the north City Limits of the City of Las Vegas, on the east by Main Street, and on the south by Bonanza Road; and


WHEREAS, civil order has been restored to the above described area and good reason exists for rescinding such Proclamation and lifting said curfew,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ORAN K. GRAGSON, Mayor of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, do hereby proclaim that the Proclamation fixing a curfew within the above described boundaries from 7:00 P.M. until 6:00 A.M. be, and the same hereby is, rescinded and set aside.
