WHEREAS, nowhere is this need more evident than in the area of human environment which has been chosen as this year's theme for National Engineers Week; and

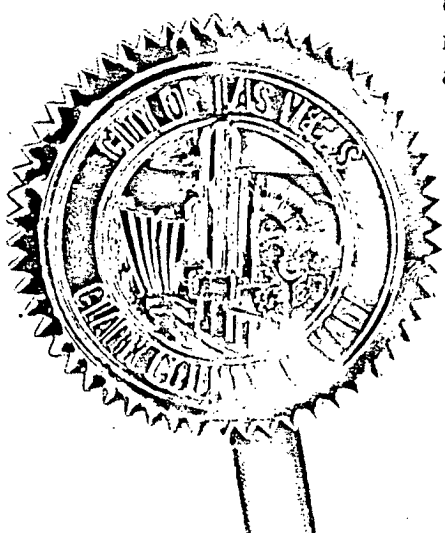
