WHEREAS, Epsilon Sigma Alpha, a non-academic sisterhood was organized in 1929 by a group of culturally minded women, and celebrates its founding with the observance of E.S.A. Week, May 1 - 7; and

WHEREAS, E.S.A. members are active women who accept the challenge to keep pace with the constant innovations in our modern social structure; and

WHEREAS, each chapter has an educational program that fits the interest of its members, such as astrology, religion, crafts, stock market, law enforcement, medicine, etc.; and

WHEREAS, E.S.A. has a membership of more than 40,000 sisters throughout the world, with a combined membership of three active chapters in the Las Vegas area having a combined membership of 75; and
