

Proclamation

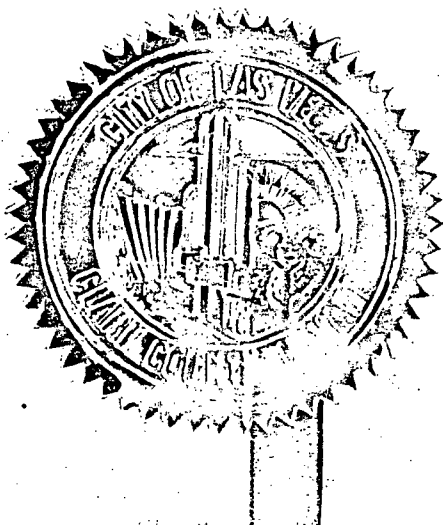
- WHEREAS, on of the greatest and most valued heritages of American citizens is the right to attain an education in the schools of this nation; and
- WHEREAS, education is the corner stone of our free and productive society, without which our nation could not progress nor maintain its leadership in the free world; and
