

Proclamation

- WHEREAS, the Region XII, Boy Scouts of America, annual meeting will be held in the City of Las Vegas November 12 through November 14, 1970; and
- WHEREAS, Region XII, Boy Scouts of America serves over 600,000 Cubs, Scouts and Explorers in over 19,000 Packs, Troops and Posts; and
- WHEREAS, Millions of American boys and men have benefited from its educational program since it began in 1910; and
- WHEREAS, The Boulder Dam Area Council, Boy Scouts of America successfully carries out the Boy Scouts of America program in this area through its partnership with over 500 school, religious, civic, and other community organizations that are chartered to use the Scout program; and
- WHEREAS, the Boy Scout movement has proven itself as a great force for the youth of the United States by encouraging the boys to do things for themselves and others, by training them in Scoutcraft, and by teaching them patriotism, courage, self-reliance and kindred virtues; and
- WHEREAS, Las Vegas will play host to the volunteer leadership of Region XII, Boy Scouts of America:
