

Proclamation

WHEREAS, Square Dancing was originally introduced in the City of Las Vegas in 1949, and the first square dancing club was formed soon thereafter; and

WHEREAS, there are presently nine active clubs in Las Vegas, including one preteen/teen club; and

WHEREAS, participation in square dancing provides a wholesome source of relaxation to the dancers and entertainment to the groups before which they perform; and

WHEREAS, Square Dancing clubs have had some small part in creating an environment which helps to produce fine young citizens, particularly through encouraging the young people to join in such worthwhile activity; and

WHEREAS, a special dance will be held as a highlight during Square Dance Week in Las Vegas:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ORAN K. GRAGSON, Mayor of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, do hereby proclaim the week of September 7 through September 13, 1970 as

SQUARE DANCE WEEK

and ask all citizens to take recognition thereof.
