WHEREAS, the right to choose one's occupation is a basic American freedom and the discovery and development of one's talents is essential to personal fulfillment, and to the continuing success of the American way of life; and

WHEREAS, many of our nation's social and economic problems arise from the frustration of persons in their attempts to achieve their creative and economic potentials; and

WHEREAS, the structure of occupations is rapidly changing, and new categories of employment for professionals, technicians, and sub professionals are being created, so that most persons now entering the employment market will make from one to three occupational changes in their lifetimes; and

WHEREAS, vocational guidance has proved to be a vital link between the increasingly complex world of work and the individual's need to select, locate and train for employment that is agreeable and rewarding,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ORAN K. GRAGSON, Mayor of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, do hereby proclaim the week of Oct. 25-31, 1970, as
