WHEREAS, a better working knowledge of the many forms of business which are the economic foundation of our community, and assistance to youth in making decisions while still in school for business careers will enhance and supplement formal educational preparation of our youth; and

WHEREAS, businessmen and businesswomen throughout Southern Nevada, in recognition of the need, and in desiring to provide youth additional opportunity for business careers, have organized a career day program for senior boys and girls; and

WHEREAS, these students, under the guidance of the sponsoring businessmen and businesswomen, will for one day participate at the management and policy-making level of the several businesses; and

WHEREAS, proceeds from sponsorship fees which support this program will establish a scholarship fund at the University of Nevada, Las Vegas, to further the business education of our youth; and

WHEREAS, certain categories of municipal and county government employment opportunities will also be presented students through the career day program,
