WHEREAS, the annual sale of Buddy Poppies by the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States has been official recognized and endorsed by governmental leaders since 1922; and

WHEREAS, V.F.W. Buddy Poppies are assembled by disabled veterans, and the proceeds of this worthy fund-raising campaign are used exclusively for the benefit of disabled and needy veterans, and the widows and orphans of deceased veterans; and

WHEREAS, the basic purpose of the annual sale of Buddy Poppies by the Veterans of Foreign Wars is eloquently reflected in the desire to "Honor the Dead by Helping the Living";

NOW, THEREFORE, I, HANK THORNLEY, Mayor Pro Tem of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, do hereby proclaim the week of November 8 through November 14, 1970 as

V.F.W. BUDDY POPPY WEEK

in the City of Las Vegas, Nevada and do hereby urge the citizens of this community to recognize the merits of this cause by contributing generously to its support through the purchase of Buddy Poppies on the day set aside for the distribution of these symbols of appreciation for the sacrifices of our honored dead.
