

Proclamation

PROCLAMATION DECLARING THAT QUESTION
BE PLACED ON THE JUNE 5, 1973, BALLOT

WHEREAS, at the meeting of the Board of City Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada on February 14, 1973, numerous citizens appeared to complain against the Adult Oriented Book Stores and Adult Oriented Theaters operating within the City of Las Vegas, Nevada; and

WHEREAS, at the same meeting there were presented to the Board of City Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, petitions containing in excess of 670 signatures of residents of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada in opposition to said Adult Oriented Book Stores and Adult Oriented Theaters; and

WHEREAS, in response to the complaints and the petitions by the citizens of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, it was moved and passed unanimously to present to the voters the question of whether or not the citizens of Las Vegas, Nevada want these types of businesses to operate within the city limits.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ORAN K. GRAGSON, Mayor of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada do hereby proclaim that the question shall be placed on the ballot for the General Election on the 5th day of June, 1973.
