

Proclamation

- WHEREAS; the tragedy of cancer is all too well known to millions of American families; and
- WHEREAS; the American Cancer Society annually conducts fund drives to provide financial support for the humanitarian and life-saving programs of medical research, public education, rehabilitation and others; and
- WHEREAS; it is the belief and goal of the medical profession that a cure for cancer can be found, and that in fact many forms of cancer already are curable if detected and treated in its early stages, and thus countless lives are saved; and
- WHEREAS; it is in the public interest to direct attention to the American Cancer Society and to the life-saving programs funded by and sponsored by this organization; and
- WHEREAS; it is proper that official recognition be given the American Cancer Society and tribute paid the thousands of citizens the nation over who volunteer their time and efforts in furthering the work of this Society; and
- WHEREAS; April 2, 1977, will mark the beginning of a week-long, door to door campaign to raise funds for continuation of the services of the American Cancer Society;
- NOW, THEREFORE, I, RON LURIE, Mayor pro-tem of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, by virtue of the authority vested in me, do hereby proclaim April 2, 1977, to be:

"CANCER CRUSADE DAY"

in and for the City of Las Vegas, and I do hereby urge all citizens to generously support this campaign.
