- Whereas;** Today, we recognize Firefighter/Paramedic Randy Farr for his quick thinking and heroic actions.
- Whereas;** On Tuesday, March 2, 2004, Engine 210 was dispatched to a vehicle accident on Paratore Way between West Charleston Boulevard and Valley View Boulevard. Upon arrival, Randy Farr found a Sport Utility Vehicle (SUV) upside down on the shoulder of the road with a male victim inside needing treatment.
- Whereas;** When the crew approached the victim to render aid, they heard gunshots. The victim was shooting at the Medics and anybody else in the immediate area. The danger of the situation was immense. At any given time, one of the crew members or civilians could have been killed.
- Whereas;** Randy Farr instinctively took control of the situation and pulled the gun from the victim/assailant to ensure his fellow crew members and civilians safety.
- Whereas;** Firefighter/Paramedic Randy Farr performed a selfless act of valor, one above and beyond the call of duty. He realized the severity of the situation and decided to put his crew and community above himself.

INSTINCTIVENESS AND HEROIC ACTIONS.


