- Whereas;** As President of the Gateway District Association, he's been instrumental in taking the members through a strategic session defining the mission of the group. Through focus group meetings, he and the Office of Business Development have identified ways to brand the area.
- Whereas;** Walt Walters is passionate about stabilizing this community and continues to dream up projects to improve the quality of life of this area. He helped coordinate the September 25 neighborhood clean up and secured the Clark High School Varsity baseball team to volunteer. He is working with other downtown neighborhoods to develop an annual fund raising event. He recently contributed to the purchase of 100 turkeys for needy families within the Gateway District.
- Whereas;** He is active in the Weed and Seed Task Force and has begun to network with other business associations (such as the Arts District, the Downtown Business Operators Council, and the Cultural Corridor Coalition) in order to develop a common vision for the downtown area.
