Whereas; April, 2004 marks the 37th Anniversary of the Civil Rights Act of 1968, and the celebration of 37 years of progress in promoting fair housing and equal opportunity for all Americans; and

Whereas; the principal of Fair Housing is not only Federal law and national policy, but a fundamental human concept and entitlement for all Americans; and

Whereas; the City of Las Vegas supports by its signature to the Community Development Block Grant grantee, Federal certification for fair housing efforts; and

Whereas; through the City's direct participation in the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, Office of Fair Housing and Equal Opportunity's Community Housing Resource Boards Program which is designed to promote voluntary housing efforts in the real estate and home builders industries as well as general public awareness of the Federal Fair Housing Law; now
