Proclamation

Whereas; Bishop Carruth Hall was born in Malvern, Arkansas on January 24, 1930. He is the husband to Loyce Wright Hall, and they are the parents to five children, Harriet Johnson, Anna Jean Lee, Estralita Williams, Curita Hall Blakely, and Carruth L. Hall II; and

Whereas; Bishop Hall was called to the Ministry at an early age and was ordained in 1957. He was a gospel recording artist singing with a quartet by the name of "The Five Harps of David" across the state of Arkansas in the late 30's and 40's. He was an Evangelist working under Bishop Walker in the state of Arkansas licensed as a National Evangelist of the Churches of God in Christ; and

Whereas; Bishop Hall is a graduate of the "Voice of Prophecy" School of Theology", C. T. S. under the late Bishop C. C. Cox, he holds an Honorary Doctorate Degree. He founded the Spiritual Renewal Ministries at the Greater St. Paul COGIC and the St. Paul Bible collage (an accredited college); and

Whereas; Bishop Hall was appointed in the areas of Nevada State Chairman of the Board of Elders and 1st Administrative Assistant to the late Bishop C.C. Cox and Bishop E.N. Webb On October 28, 1993. He was appointed by the then Presiding Bishop, Bishop L. H. Ford, as Prelate of the 1st Ecclesiastical Jurisdiction of Nevada; he held that position until 2011. He served as the President of the Charles Harrison Mason Bible College. He was later appointed as the Chaplain of the Collage of Bishops for the Churches of God in Christ International; and

Whereas; Bishop Hall has faithfully served as pastor of the Greater St. Paul Church of God in Christ for 50 years. As a shepherd providing programs and Outreach Ministries for members and the community, he has overseen counseling, feeding the homeless, and Evangelistical services for members training in Bible study; and now
