REQUEST TO ABATE NUISANCE

As part of the City of Las Vegas ongoing effort to beautify the City, we are requiring your assistance in a City-wide cleanup program. In many cases by abating litter nuisance a potential fire hazard is often corrected.

As the owners of the property located at 2019 Hamilton Lane trash and litter

4-ton trucker is being kept there plus we are appealing to you to take whatever action is necessary to improve the appearance of your property by removing the 4 ton truck and cleaning up the lot. garbage and litter is getting into the next house and we have been informed the truck belongs to a Ira Kuiavas. The maintenance of the lot is the owner's responsibility.

The City Code clearly states the responsibility and penalties for violations involving nuisance litter are that of the owner. We are hoping the citizens, after being notified, will voluntarily respond within 30 days from the receipt of this letter and correct the undesirable condition so that no formal action by the City will be necessary.

We all would enjoy a cleaner and safer environment. However, without the contribution of individual efforts from the citizenry, no community betterment program would ever be successful.

Therefore, we are asking your help to achieve this goal.
