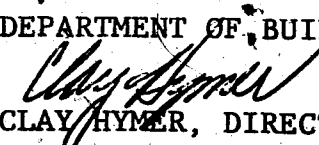
As the owner of the property located at 713 Casino Center Boulevard, we are appealing to you to take whatever action is necessary to improve the appearance of your property by removing and safely disposing of the trash, debris, and dry vegetation from said property.

The City Code clearly states the responsibility and penalties for violations involving nuisance litter are that of the owner. We are hoping the citizens, after being notified, will voluntarily respond within thirty (30) days from the receipt of this letter and correct the undesirable condition so that no formal action by the City will be necessary.
