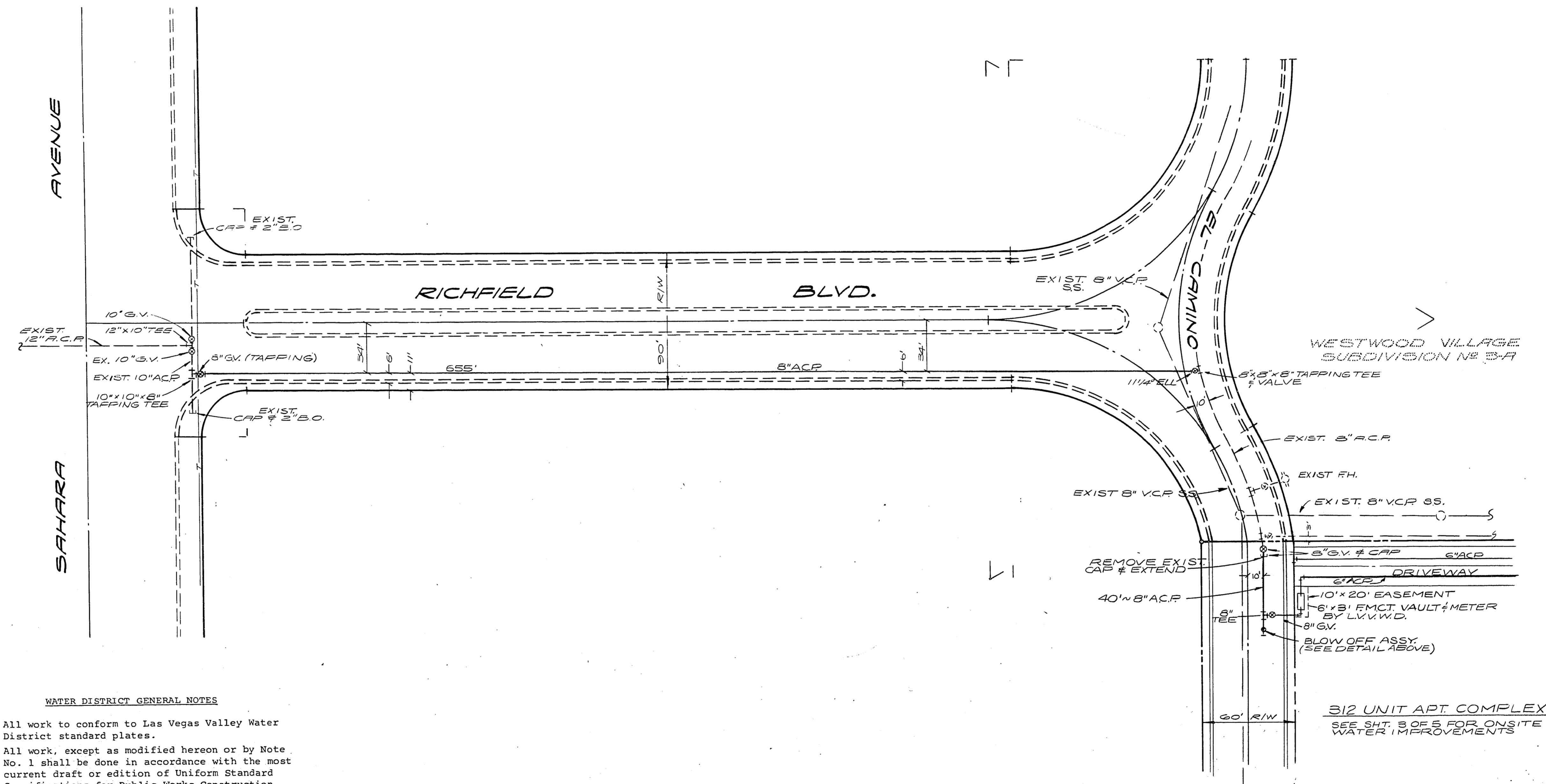


BLOW-OFF ASSEMBLY

WATER DISTRICT GENERAL NOTES

1. All work to conform to Las Vegas Valley Water District standard plates.
2. All work, except as modified hereon or by Note No. 1 shall be done in accordance with the most current draft or edition of Uniform Standard Specifications for Public Works Construction Offsite Improvements Clark County Area, 1976.
3. Notice to be given Engineering Department of the Las Vegas Valley Water District 48 hours prior to actual construction.
4. Service saddles or tapped collars will be required on all services, double tap collars are not permitted.
5. All lines to be pressure tested to 200 psi.
6. All valve boxes shall have concrete collars at surface of paved areas.
7. Deflection angle shall not exceed 5 degrees per 13 foot section of pipe for pipe sizes smaller than 10 inches and shall not exceed 3 degrees for pipe sizes 10 inches and larger.
8. All meters shall be located outside of driveways.

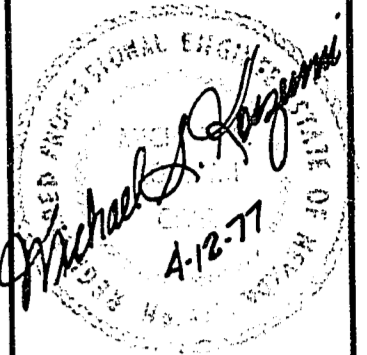
