

ENGINEER'S CERTIFICATE

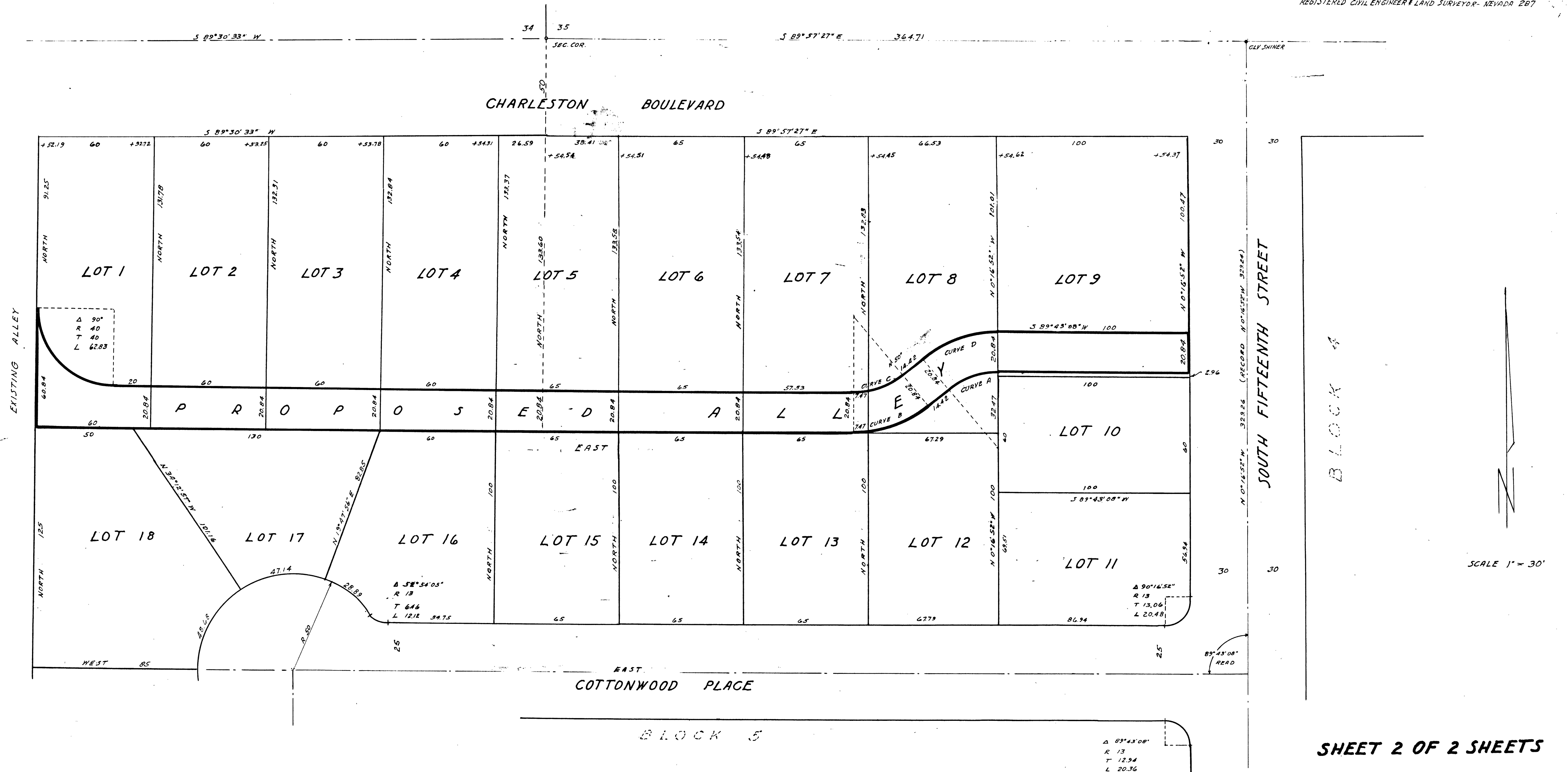
I, F.M. EATON, a duly Registered Civil Engineer and Land Surveyor, do hereby certify that this map truly and correctly represents the results of a survey made by me of a portion of Block 3, Huntridge Subdivision, at the instance of HUNTRIDGE DEVELOPMENT COMPANY, owners of said land. The purpose of this survey is to define the limits of a proposed alley to run from South Fifteenth Street across the southerly portions of these lots in Block 3 facing on Charleston Boulevard to connect with an existing alley lying between Block 3 and Block 25, also to determine the dimensions of the lots facing on Charleston Boulevard as they exist subsequent to a realignment of Charleston Boulevard and the vacation of certain portions of that area formerly dedicated for street purposes.

The portion of Block 3 which is included in the alley is more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a point on the east line of Lot 9, Block 3, distant 2.94 feet from the southeast corner thereof; thence westerly, parallel to the south line of said Lot 9, a distance of 100.00 feet to a point; thence, turning to the left along the arc of a circle of radius 38.16 feet, tangent to the last mentioned line and subtending a central angle of 39°43'08" on an arc distance of 27.15 feet to a point; thence southwesterly, tangent to said arc, a distance of 14.42 feet to a point; thence, turning to the right along the arc of a circle of radius 60 feet, tangent to the last mentioned line, and subtending a central angle of 40° on an arc distance of 41.08 feet to a point on the south line of Lot 7 distant 7.47 feet from the southeast corner thereof; thence westerly along the south line of Lots 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2 and a distance of 427.33 feet to the southwest corner of Lot 1; thence

northerly along the west line of Lot 1 a distance of 60.84 feet to a point; thence turning southeasterly through the arc of a circle, concave to the north, of radius 40 feet, tangent to the last mentioned line and subtending a central angle of 30°, on an arc distance of 62.83 feet to a point; thence easterly, tangent to aforesaid arc and parallel to the south line of Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7, and distant 20.84 feet therefrom, a distance of 387.53 feet to a point; thence, turning to the left along the arc of a circle of radius 39.16 feet, tangent to the last mentioned line and subtending a central angle of 40°, on an arc distance of 27.34 feet to a point; thence north-easterly, tangent to the aforesaid arc, a distance of 14.42 feet to a point; thence, turning to the right along the arc of a circle of radius 60 feet, tangent to the last mentioned line and subtending a central angle of 39°43'08" on an arc distance of 41.08 feet to a point on the east line of Lot 8, distant 33.31 feet from the southeast corner thereof; thence tangent to the preceding arc a parallel to and 23.80 feet distant from the south line of Lot 9 a distance of 100 feet to a point on the east line of Lot 9; thence southerly along said east line of Lot 9 a distance of 20.84 feet to the point of beginning.

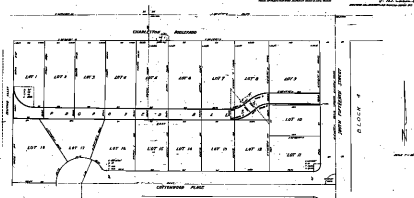
