3) Approximate location of underground utilities shown on the drawings were obtained from G.C. Wallace, Inc.. Neither the Owner, G.C. Wallace, nor the Landscape Architect assumes any responsibility for utilities or structures not shown, or not in the locations shown on the drawings. Contractor to verify the exact location of utilities prior to construction. (CALL BEFORE YOU DIG) The Contractor's responsibility regarding utilities shall be as required under Section 107.17 of the Uniform Standard Specifications for Clark County area, and as provided in the specifications. The Contractor shall use extreme caution when working over or near existing electrical lines. Special precautions shall be taken when installing new irrigation controller near the existing electrical pedestal/irrigation controller.

4) The Contractor shall take all precautionary measures necessary to protect existing improvements from damage and all such improvements or structures damaged by the Contractor's operations shall be repaired or reconstructed satisfactory to the Owner's Representative at the expense of the Contractor.

5) Discrepancies between the plans and site conditions within the limits of work shall be brought to the attention of the Owner's Representative prior to starting construction.

6) Staging areas shall be coordinated with the Owner's Representative.

7) Contractor shall verify all quantities and is responsible for installing all plants, gravel mulch, irrigation, etc. as shown on the drawings regardless of discrepancies with written quantities.

8) The landscape and irrigation work shall be completed under one contract.

GRADING:

9) Grading includes minor reshaping of landscape areas as required, or as directed by the Owner's Representative. Grade areas smooth to minimize irregularities and provide uniform slope profile where required. Refer to Landscape Grading Section 02923.

10) Clear, grub, and remove all weeds, debris, and rock over 6" dia. in all landscape areas. Repair grades and compact areas prior to planting and mulching.

11) Finish grade refers to top of soil elevation, not including gravel mulch.

PLANTING:

12) Plant trees and shrubs in locations as shown on drawings, and in accordance with planting details.

IRRIGATION:

13) Install irrigation system in locations as shown on drawings, and in accordance with irrigation details.
