PLANTING NOTES:

- Contractor shall be responsible for all permits, coordination, scheduling, utility verification and damage to other trades and/or utilities, as per contract general conditions.
- Contractor shall verify all site conditions and report any and all discrepancy to the Landscape Architect and Construction Project Representative prior to starting construction.
- Contractor shall verify locations of existing underground utilities prior to start of construction. Call before you Dig 1-800-22T-2600.
- Contractor shall limit work areas to that shown on the drawings.
- Contractor shall perform finish grading modifications to areas requiring grading, or as directed by the Construction Project Representative. Grade areas smooth to minimize irregularities and low spots.
- Layout of all plant material in planting areas shall be approved by the Construction Project Representative prior to installation. Coordinate these areas with irrigation layout.
- Plant quantities and square footage of decomposed granite are for convenience only. CONTRACTOR IS RESPONSIBLE TO VERIFY.
- See details and specifications for planting procedures.
- See details and specifications for gravel mulch procedures.
- See details and specifications for decomposed granite procedures.
- Contractor shall excavate and remove all caliche encountered during planting operations. Excavate to the required depth as indicated on the drawings. Remove and properly dispose of excavated caliche from site.

PLANTING NOTES:

- 12 Distributor shall be responsible for all permits, construction, scheduling, safety, ventilation and design to other trades on-site within, as per various permit conditions.
- 13 Distributor shall verify all site conditions and report any and all conditions to the contractor, the contractor and Construction Project Representative prior to starting construction.
- 14 Distributor shall verify location of existing overhead electrical address prior to start of construction. Call before you dig 1-800-368-5898.
- 15 Contractor shall not work outside of the chain of the design.
- 16 Contractor shall perform final grading construction to areas indicated on the plan or as directed by the contractor and Construction Project Representative for the site. This includes foundation and low walls.
- 17 Layout of all sites must be planned and shall be approved by the Construction Project Representative prior to land clearing. Contractor must submit a site layout plan.
- 18 Plans, quantities and schedule of proposed grading are not construction only. CONTRACTOR IS RESPONSIBLE TO ADAPT.
- 19 Site details and specifications for planting specimens.
- 20 Site details and specifications for ground-level procedures.
- 21 Site details and specifications for development of the specimen.
- 22 Contractor shall maintain and remove all site materials during planting operations. Remove all site materials from the site prior to the end of the day. Remove and properly dispose of all materials on the site.
