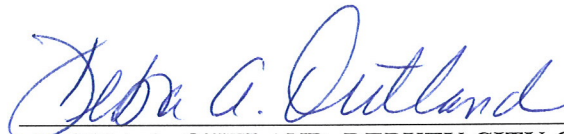

ITEM DESCRIPTION: HPC-63285 - For possible action regarding 2016 Historic Preservation and Archaeology Month theme and activities, All Wards

BACKGROUND

12/10/14 HPC approved (HPC-56943) the HPC Centennial Legacy Budget.

ANALYSIS

Staff is requesting approval of the proposed theme and activities for Historic Preservation and Archaeology Awareness Month (HPAM). The HPC has budgeted \$2,000 to celebrate HPAM.

National Preservation Month

May is National Preservation Month. The Nevada State Historic Preservation Office and the National Trust for Historic Preservation have not announced their theme yet.

Las Vegas HPAM 2016 Theme

Staff recommends a theme which honors the 50th anniversary of the National Historic Preservation Act.

Las Vegas HPAM 2016 Activities

The Commission is encouraged to submit ideas for activities related to the proposed theme.

Historic Preservation Commission Annual Awards for Excellence in Historic Preservation

Each year the HPC recognizes individuals and organizations for excellence in historic preservation. The date, time and location of the award ceremony are to be determined.

HPAM Proclamation

Mayor Goodman or HPC Chairman Stoldal will read the Historic Preservation Month Proclamation and present the annual HPC Historic Preservation Month awards. The date, time and location of the award ceremony are to be determined.

Helldorado Days

May 14, 2016, 10:00 am, Downtown Parade Route. The city of Las Vegas and the Benevolent and Protective Order of the Elks Lodge No.1468 are partnering again for the Helldorado Days celebration. The HPC partners with local antique car clubs to participate in the parade.
