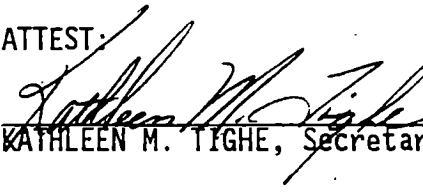
WHEREAS, at this time there are no state laws or statutes which require a prospective bidder to use minority or local sub-contractors or suppliers; and

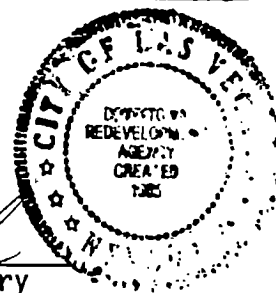
