

**RESOLUTION UPDATING THE PROCEDURE FOR FILING OBJECTIONS TO
CITY ORDINANCES OR RESOLUTIONS WHICH HAVE AN IMPACT
ON BUSINESS (NRS 237.030 ET SEQ.)**

WHEREAS, during its 1999 legislative session, the Nevada Legislature adopted provisions now codified in NRS 237.030 et seq., requiring local governments to consider and evaluate the impact on business of certain types of legislation; and

WHEREAS, NRS 237.100 establishes a process by which a business may object to certain types of local legislation, and specifically requires local governments to provide a procedure for pursuing such objections; and

WHEREAS, by means of Resolution R-5-2000, the City Council adopted such a procedure for the City, and amended that procedure by means of Resolution R-14-2017 because of intervening changes to NRS 237.030 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, in its regular session of 2019, the Nevada Legislature again amended the provisions of NRS 237.030 et seq. in a number of respects; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to update the procedure adopted for the City in 2000 and updated in 2017 to take into account the most recent legislative changes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BASED UPON THE FOREGOING, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The attached procedure for filing objections is adopted.
2. Copies of the attached procedure shall be maintained in the Office of the City Clerk.
3. Staff is authorized to develop any forms deemed appropriate for use in connection with the attached procedure.

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1 4. This Resolution and attached procedure supersede R-14-2017 and the procedure adopted pursuant
2 thereto.

3 5. This Resolution shall become effective October 1, 2019.

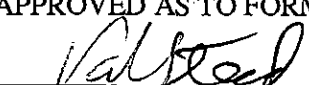

**PROCEDURE FOR FILING OBJECTIONS TO CITY ORDINANCES OR RESOLUTIONS
WHICH HAVE AN IMPACT ON BUSINESS (NRS 237.030 ET SEQ.)**

1. If a business believes it is aggrieved by an ordinance or resolution adopted by the City Council, the business may object by filing a petition in writing with the City Clerk, at 495 S. Main Street, 2nd Floor, Las Vegas, Nevada 89101.
2. The City will accept such petitions for a period of thirty (30) days following approval of the subject ordinance or resolution for one of the following reasons:
 - a. The City failed to prepare a business impact statement as required pursuant to NRS Chapter 237;
 - b. The business impact statement prepared by the City was inaccurate, incomplete or did not adequately consider or significantly underestimated the economic effect of the rule on businesses; or
 - c. The City failed to comply with any of the requirements of NRS 237.030 et seq. before adopting the ordinance or resolution.
3. Upon receipt of a petition, the City Clerk will forward a copy to the City Attorney, the Department or agency which generated the legislative action, and the City Manager.
4. Staff will consider the merits of the petition and forward a recommendation to the City Council.
5. The City Council will determine if the petition has merit and direct staff accordingly.
