

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS during the past year the City of Las Vegas, a municipal corporation in Clark County, Nevada, did acquire from the then owner, Western Air Express Corporation, its airport located about nine miles north east of said City of Las Vegas, and has since acquired additional lands adjoining the same, all to be used as a municipal airport, and

WHEREAS thereafter the said City of Las Vegas did enter into an agreement with Civil Aeronautics Administration of the United States for the improvement of said airport, and did thereafter and on January 25th, 1941, enter into an agreement with the United States of America, through its War Department, for the further development and improvement of said Airport, and its use by the United States as a military airport, and

WHEREAS during such negotiations the officials of the said City of Las Vegas have been thrown in close contact with divers agents and representatives of the United States, and

WHEREAS much of the detail looking to the development and improvement of said Airport by the United States has been handled by and through the United States Engineer Office, 751 South Figueroa Street, Los Angeles, California, and

WHEREAS, the individual representing said United States Engineer Office, who has made several trips to Las Vegas working with different representatives of the City of Las Vegas and others, in the furtherance of the development of said airport, is Mr. Earl N. Tandberg, and

WHEREAS all relations, discussions, negotiations and transactions between the different representatives of the said City of Las Vegas and the said Earl N. Tandberg have been most cordial and satisfactory and beneficial both to the United States of America and to the said City of Las Vegas, and

1 WHEREAS, because of his knowledge of engineering, his wide
2 experience, his perception of human nature, his ability to clearly
3 and succinctly present a difficult problem, and finally point the way
4 to a solution of the same, it has been a pleasure to work with him,
5 and

6 WHEREAS, the Mayor and Members of the Board of Commissioners
7 of the Said City of Las Vegas desire to express their appreciation of
8 the work done by the said Earl N. Tandberg, and the gratitude of the
9 entire City of Las Vegas to him for the future benefits to flow to
10 the said City of Las Vegas from the efforts so expended.

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners
12 of the City of Las Vegas, Clark County, Nevada, in regular meeting
13 assembled, that Earl N. Tandberg of the United States Engineer Office,
14 751 South Figueroa Street, Los Angeles, California, be and he is
15 hereby made, constituted and appointed

16 HONORARY MAYOR of the City of Las Vegas.

17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this
18 Resolution be forwarded to the said Earl N. Tandberg, in care of
19 United States Engineer Office, 751 South Figueroa Street, Los Angeles,
20 California.

21 Commissioner Rennew proposed the adoption of the
