

RESOLUTION DESIGNATING A PORTION OF BAKER PARK AS A CHILDREN'S PARK

WHEREAS, LVMC Chapter 13.36 is concerned with the administration and regulation of City parks;

and

WHEREAS, LVMC Chapter 13.36.150 authorizes the establishment and regulation of children's parks, which are parks intended primarily for the use of children twelve years of age or younger; and

WHEREAS, as part of its focus on the preservation of neighborhoods, the City Council believes it is important to have parks within the community that provide a safe and comfortable recreational environment for children; and

WHEREAS, Baker Park, on East St. Louis Avenue, is located in a densely populated, historic neighborhood, including both residential and commercial properties; and

WHEREAS, the present environment found in Baker Park includes security concerns that are inconsistent with the use and enjoyment of the park by children; and

WHEREAS, because of the proximity of Baker Park to the historic neighborhood where families have little to no other close park environment, the City Council finds it in the interest of the public health, safety, and welfare to designate a portion of Baker Park as a children's park, which will then be subject to all of the provisions of LVMC 13.36 that govern children's parks.

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1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS
2 VEGAS, pursuant to and in accordance with LVMC 13.36.150, that a portion of Baker Park, identified in the
3 map attached hereto as Attachment A, be designated as a children's park.

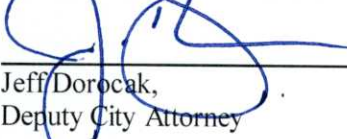
