2 **ORDINANCE NO. 6804**

3 AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND VARIOUS PROVISIONS OF LVMC TITLE 7 TO INCREASE FROM
4 THREE TO FOUR THE NUMBER OF DOGS, CATS, FERRETS OR RABBITS THAT CAN BE KEPT
5 AT A PARTICULAR PLACE OR RESIDENCE WITHOUT A SPECIFIC PERMIT TO DO SO, AND TO
6 PROVIDE FOR OTHER RELATED MATTERS.

Summary: Amends various provisions of LVMC
7 Title 7 to increase from three to four the number
8 of dogs, cats, ferrets or rabbits that can be kept at
a particular place or residence without a specific
permit to do so.

9 THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS
10 FOLLOWS:

11 SECTION 1: Title 7, Chapter 8, Section 140, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las
12 Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

13 **7.08.140:** Except as otherwise provided in Section 7.08.150, no person shall keep more than [three]
14 four dogs over three months of age, at any place, on any premises, or in any one residence, located within the
15 City.

16 SECTION 2: Title 7, Chapter 8, Section 160, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las
17 Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

18 **7.08.160:** Except as otherwise provided in Section 7.08.170, no person shall keep more than [three]
19 four cats over four months of age, at any place, or on any premises, or in any one residence, located within
20 the City.

21 SECTION 3: Title 7, Chapter 8, Section 185, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las
22 Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

23 **7.08.185:** No person shall keep more than [three] four ferrets over four months of age at any residence
24 or premises within the City.

25 SECTION 4: Title 7, Chapter 38, Section 60, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las
26 Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

1 **7.38.060:** Except as otherwise provided in this Title, no person shall keep more than [three] four rabbits
2 over four months of age at any place, on any premises, or in any one residence located within the City.

3 SECTION 5: If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase
4 in this ordinance or any part thereof is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid or ineffective by
5 any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the
6 remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof. The City Council of the City of Las Vegas hereby
7 declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase
8 thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs,
9 sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.

10 SECTION 6: Whenever in this ordinance any act is prohibited or is made or declared to
11 be unlawful or an offense or a misdemeanor, or whenever in this ordinance the doing of any act is required
12 or the failure to do any act is made or declared to be unlawful or an offense or a misdemeanor, the doing of
13 such prohibited act or the failure to do any such required act shall constitute a misdemeanor and upon
14 conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$1,000.00 or by imprisonment for a term of
15 not more than six months, or by any combination of such fine and imprisonment. Any day of any violation
16 of this ordinance shall constitute a separate offense.

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SECTION 7: All ordinances or parts of ordinances or sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.



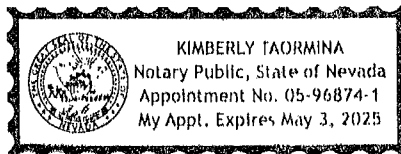
