In 2000 the City Council adopted the Downtown Centennial Plan, along with related design standards, to guide development in the downtown area. The Plan has been updated in order to reflect and address changing conditions, goals, priorities and strategies, and this bill will adopt the updated Plan. The updated Plan was approved by the Planning Commission on January 26, 2006, and will replace and supersede the 2000 Plan.
