19 **COUNCILMAN REESE**

20 Abeyance item, discussion and possible action regarding approval of a new Liquor  
21 License, Liquor Caterer License, Scotch 80's Limited, doing business as Squiggy's, 3805  
22 West Sahara Avenue, Danny R. Piper Director, President, Treasurer, 50 percent and

26 **MAYOR GOODMAN**

27 Thank you, I – think, does my abstention spill over to this?

29 **BRAD JERBIC**

30 I – think, Your Honor, that, I don't know (inaudible) but I recommend that it should. And  
31 I think that Mr. DiFiore's recommendation is going to be to table this until August 16<sup>th</sup> as  
32 well, so that these are both heard together. Is that correct –

35 Alright, very good, then I'll turn this over to Mayor Pro-Tem. Thank you.

53 It – would be your choice. You wanna hold it for 30 days then?

56 If I could make a suggestion, we could bring it up on the 16<sup>th</sup> to be heard after the  
57 disciplinary complaint is heard and if at that point, Councilwoman, there – still seems to  
58 be some uncertainty we continue it one more time. But that's just a suggestion.

60 **COUNCILWOMAN TARKANIAN**

61 Alright, that would be fine with me. **I would move accordingly.**

63 **MAYOR PRO-TEM REESE**

64 Okay, **the motion then would be to hold Item Number 44 in abeyance until August**  
65 **the 16<sup>th</sup>, not to be heard before Item 43.**

68 It will fall that way on the Agenda, we're fine.
