PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

NDOT is currently pursuing environmental clearance for operational improvements to I-15 from the Spaghetti Bowl to the Apex Interchange, a distance of approximately 15 miles. The first phase of the project would include adding lanes from the Spaghetti bowl to Craig Road. The subsequent phases would extend from Craig Road to the Speedway Interchange. Phase I request for proposal release date is tentatively scheduled for October 2006, with final selection taking approximately 6 months. Total estimated construction time for Phase I of this project is two years, beginning in April of 2007.
