PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

Southern Nevada has three (3) Housing Authorities which are the Housing Authority of the city of Las Vegas, Clark County Housing Authority and Housing Authority of the city of North Las Vegas. Public Housing within the city of Henderson is administered by Clark County Housing Authority. In March 2006, the SNRPC board recommended shared funding for the purposes of conducting a feasibility study for possible consolidation of Housing Authority programs and/or agencies. To that end, representatives from each housing authority, municipality, and Clark County, have formed a committee to develop the RFP in order to ascertain the feasibility of consolidation of Housing Authority programs and/or agencies. Clark County and the cities of North Las Vegas and Henderson are also contributing financially to the study.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends approval of the Interlocal Agreement with Clark County and the cities of North Las Vegas, and Henderson for shared funding of the RFP for Phase I of the Housing Authority Consolidation Feasibility Study.
