

INTERLOCAL CONTRACT

MARTIN L. KING/INDUSTRIAL ROAD, WYOMING AVENUE TO PALOMINO LANE

THIS INTERLOCAL CONTRACT, made and entered into this 16TH day of August, 2006 by and between the CITY OF LAS VEGAS, a municipal corporation, hereinafter referred to as the "CITY" and the Regional Transportation Commission of Southern Nevada hereinafter referred to as "RTC".

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 373 of the Nevada Revised Statutes, a Project to design, purchase right-of-way, perform construction inspection and construct roadway improvements for Martin L. King Boulevard/Industrial Road, Wyoming Avenue to Palomino Lane located wholly within the CITY, has been approved by the Regional Transportation Commission.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the covenants, conditions, agreements, and promises of the parties hereto, the RTC authorizes the CITY to proceed with the PROJECT as it is mutually understood and agrees as follows.

SECTION I - SCOPE OF PROJECT

This Interlocal Contract applies to improvements associated with Martin L. King Boulevard/Industrial Road, Wyoming Avenue to Palomino Lane. The basic improvements include but are not limited to; survey, earthwork, curb, gutter, sidewalks, amenity zone pavement, traffic signs, street lighting, pavement, pavement markings, water and sewer mains, and all other required components.

SECTION II- PROJECT COST

The RTC agrees to provide funding for project costs according to Section 6.1 REIMBURSEMENT COSTS of the Policies and Procedures Manual of the RTC within the limits specified below:

1. The total cost for engineering design, contract administration, surveying, inspection, testing, right-of-way engineering, right-of-way negotiations and acquisition, utility relocation and construction shall not exceed \$30,000,000 which includes all of the above items.
2. "Authorization to Proceed" for right of way acquisition at a cost not to exceed \$1,950,000 and right-of-way drawings, descriptions and obtaining appraisals at a cost not to exceed \$50,000 at the time written Authorization to Proceed is received from the RTC.
3. A supplemental interlocal contract will be required for engineering, construction, and construction management.
4. A written request must be made to the RTC and an additional supplemental interlocal contract approved to allow exceptions to the adopted policies and procedures of the RTC or the amount noted above prior to payment of any additional funds.

SECTION III - GENERAL

1. The title sheet of both the plans and specifications shall show the RTC as the funding agency.
2. Preliminary engineering, design and right-of-way engineering shall be performed by the CITY or by a consultant employed by the CITY.
3. The construction and contract administration of the Project shall comply with the requirements as set forth in the current "Policies and Procedures" of the RTC.
4. Construction costs shall be paid directly to the contractor based on estimates prepared by the CITY.


