PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

The Traffic Engineering Division is requesting that a speed limit of 35 mph be established on Homestretch Drive from Hualapai Way to Grand Canyon Drive. The speed limit is posted at the 25 mph prima facie speed limit. Studies conducted on this roadway showed that the 85th percentile speed was 49 mph. Staff feels that 35 mph is the appropriate speed limit for this type of roadway because it is a residential collector street and the surrounding roadways are also posted at 35 mph.
