CITY MANAGER SELBY reported on the following upcoming events throughout the City: A Back to School Fair will be held at Polly Gonzalez Park at the corner of El Campo Grande and Bradley Road. Other Back to School Fairs will be held throughout the month at various locations. The next Coffee with the Mayor will be held in Ward One, and COUNCILWOMAN TARKANIAN will be joining the Mayor at the Starbucks at 651 N. Rainbow Boulevard. Later that morning, the Mayor will host his Open Door Meeting in the Council Chambers. A Special Job and Opportunity Fair will take place Tuesday, August 22, 2006, in conjunction with the World Market Center, the Molasky Group and area trade unions. The next day, a groundbreaking ceremony will take place to launch the construction of Discovery Drive, which will connect Grand Central Parkway to Martin Luther King, a critical link to downtown. First Friday, a much supported City event, will take place in the Arts District on September 1, starting at 6:00 p.m.
