**PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:**

The City is a wastewater agency member of the Clean Water Coalition (CWC), a joint powers agency established through an interlocal agreement among the cities of Las Vegas, Henderson, North Las Vegas, and the Clark County Water Reclamation District. The CWC is the constructor and operator of the regional Systems Conveyance and Operations Program, a conveyance system intended to assure a certain water quality level of the Las Vegas Wash and Lake Mead. The interlocal agreement authorizes CWC to assess its member agencies based on a regional connection charge schedule. This bill will pass the regional charge through to wastewater system users.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

This bill should be submitted to a Recommending Committee for review, hearing and recommendation to the City Council for final action.
