**PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:**

This Contract provides for a study to determine the feasibility of shared information technologies services infrastructure among the City, the State of Nevada, Clark County, and the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department. Through an Interlocal Agreement, each agency would share equitably in the cost of the Contract. The City's portion would be \$49,996.50.
